## Research Activities in Support of the Olympics in Rio (RASOR) - Social Unrest Movement Database Data Dictionary

**Date** – Date of event

**Type** – Type of event, options include:

- Annual\_March: gathering to commemorate an annual event (i.e. gay pride, pro-life march, religious rights march, etc.)
- Assembly: gathering, usually organized by a labor union, to discuss and/or vote on specific topic(s). For example, whether to continue a labor strike.
- Attempted\_Occupation: attempted occupation/squatting of a building using tents, etc.
- Campout: tent set-ups inside or outside buildings
- Celebration: gathering to celebrate an occurrence
- Counter\_Protest: gathering to counter other protesters
- Exhibit Artistic exhibit for/against a cause
- *Gathering*: large, peaceful gatherings, usually unrelated to political occurrences, to express demands
- March
- Motorcade: protest performed on moving vehicles (usually taxis, motorcycles, or bicycles)
- Occupation: protesters occupying the inside of a building
- Pamphlets: protesters handing out pamphlets for/against a cause
- Performance: artistic performance for/against a cause
- Pot\_Bangings: protesters banging pots for/against a cause either inside their homes or out in streets
- Protest
- Protest Against Olympics: protest against Olympic games
- Strike: workers on strike protesting for/against a cause
- Traffic\_Blockade: protesting on street, highway, etc. in attempts to block traffic
- Transit Stop: public transportation workers blocking exit of vehicles from stations
- Vigil: gathering in vigil/remembrance of individual's death
- Virtual: virtual protest

**Type\_2** – Type of event, used when event falls into multiple categories

**Violence** – Presence of violence at event, denoted by death, injury, or clashes amongst protesters for/against a cause or protesters and security forces (True/False)

**Injuries** – Number of injuries reported during the event (NR: None Reported)

**Deaths** – Number of deaths reported during the event (NR: None Reported)

**Property\_Damage** - Damage to property during the event. For example, damage to buildings, vehicles, public property, etc. as a result of broken windows/doors, fires, graffiti, etc. (NR or True)

**Arrests\_Detained** – Number of individuals arrested or detained during the event

**Moved\_Location** – Whether individuals moved from the event's starting location (i.e. a march)

Nationwide – Event is part of a larger organized protest occurring across the country (True/False)

**Across\_Locations** – Event is part of a larger organized protest occurring across multiple locations within the same city or state (True/False)

Start\_Address - Address or landmark where event originated

Latitude/Longitude – Latitude and longitude associated with Start Address

**Trajectory** – If individuals moved locations during course of event, the trajectory they took to arrive to *End\_Address* 

End\_Address - Address or landmark where event ended

City – City where event occurred

State - State where event occurred

**Location\_Notes** – Additional notes regarding *Start Address* or *End Address* 

Reason - Reason(s) for event

**Sub\_Reason** – Additional reasons for event

Pro\_Dilma - Event in support of President Dilma Rousseff and/or against impeachment

Anti\_Dilma - Event against President Dilma Rousseff and/or advocating for impeachment

Attendance\_Organizers - Number of individuals present at event, according to event's organizers

Attendance\_Media - Number of individuals present at event, according to media sources

**Attendance\_MP\_BP\_SSP\_Gov** – Number of individuals present at event, according to official government sources (usually security forces)

**Start\_Time** – Start time of event, in local time

**End\_Time** – End time of event, in local time

**Participant\_1 – Participant\_20** – Name of individual(s) or name/acronym of group(s) participating in the event. Refer to *cluster\_types* tab for full name of group associated with displayed acronyms

**Cluster\_1 – Cluster\_20** – Cluster to which participating group belongs

**Is\_Organizer\_1 – Is\_Organizer\_20** – Respective participant is an organizer/co-organizer of event (True/False)

**Notes** – Additional notes regarding the event: deaths, injuries, property damage, participants, reasons, etc.

**Sources** – Media, social media, and/or participants' website sources where information about event can be accessed
